



SAMPLE QUESTIONS FOR WEATHERING RAINBOWS

BACKSTORY

Where are you from? How did that impact your "Coming Out" story? When did you know you were LGBTQ+? What was the reaction of family, and friends? Did you grow up religious or in the church? Tell us anything relevant to how your backstory shaped your LGBTQ+ experience.

LGBTQ+ EXPERIENCE

Growing up did you have a preconceived idea or opinion about LGBTQ+ people? What did you not expect after coming out? What do you think needs to be changed about the LGBTQ+ community? What do you love about the community?

INFLUENCE

Who influenced you or helped you on your journey? Who is your favorite LGBTQ+ role model? What did you see growing up that inspired you to come out and be true to yourself?

ALL ABOUT YOU

Person Specific. Tell us about your music, your art, your book, your TikTok fame, your organization, your passion, your pageants, your drag career. This is a chance for you to shine and for us to help promote you!

ADVICE

What 3 Dos and 3 Don'ts of advice would you give to LGBTQ+ individuals? Pick a topic that is relevant to you or just something fun. In the past we have had Do's and Don'ts of "Drag", of "Creating TikToks", of "Flirting From Across The Room". The more fun the topic, the more fun for our listeners.

H.O.T.

Tell us your most comedic LGBTQ+ story or experience? Basically, tell us any funny story that relates to gay world and your experience in it. H.O.T. segment stands for Heap of Trouble (for the awkward moments we find ourselves in on occasion).

FRAME

Person Specific. Many of our shows we like to frame around a certain topic, for instance; experience as a foreign refugee, coping with addictions, surviving an eating disorder, being TikTok Famous, Music Creation, etc... We have sent you questions specific to your shows frame within the email.

AUDIENCE

Near the end of the show, we always ask our guest to give a direct message to LGBTQ+ college age kids and youth. This is your chance to be encouraging, give survival tips and pointers on how to handle lifes ups and downs.

POT OF GOLD

At the end of the show, you get to ask a question to Kurtis Sunset and a question to Leah Halston. You can ask them both the same question or both a different question. This can be on anything you want to know. The funnier the better. :)
